FAQ 1: Student Teaching Placements

IAC 281 - 79.14

Follow your approved curriculum exhibit

Provide adequate experience for each endorsement

Ask us for specifics



FAQ 2: Faculty Assignments: Coursework

IAC 281-79.12(2) The unit documents the alignment of teaching duties for each faculty member with that member's preparation, knowledge, experiences and skills.

Knowledge - through study and professional development

Preparation - content and grade level

Experience - content and grade level



FAQ 3: Faculty Assignments: Supervision

IAC 281-79.12(2) The unit documents the alignment of **teaching** duties for each faculty member with that member's preparation, knowledge, experiences and skills.

Supervision: observe, provide feedback, instruct (aka: **teaching**)

Evaluation (principals) is PK-12: HR function, not teaching

Supervisor focus is PK, coop can provide CK

Focus: grade level, content (endorsement)



FAQ 4: Recency Requirement (aka 40 hours)

IAC 281- 79.12(5)

Code (IC 256) specifies team teaching for teacher preparation

Ch 79 requires similar for admin, other (counselor, school psych, etc.)

Interact with practitioners and students as appropriate

40 hours in a five year period

79.15(6) Program completion assessments
